

Kannada Sahitya Sammelana: Fewer accommodations in Haveri; Registering sooner could help organisers make arrangements

THE district administration is taking up preparations on a war footing for the 86th Kannada Sahitya Sammelana to be held in Haveri city, the land of Sarvajanya, between January 6 and 8.

Over three lakh people are expected to attend the three day long Kannada festival and

this time, the administration is expecting more footfalls. As there are only a few hotels in Haveri district, the administration is planning to convert hostels and community halls into accommodation places.

"Besides the hotels in the city, we have identified community halls and hostels in Haveri where people coming for the Sammelana can be accom-

modated. Few alterations such as adding additional toilets, bathrooms and bedding will be done. Additionally, temporary toilets will be provided at the accommodation sites. CCTVs will be installed at all the staying places to ensure safety," said an official from the administration.

"We are expecting to open the registration by December first week. We request participants to register soon to ensure hassle-free stay during the Sammelana. Soon, KaSaPa members and senior writers will have a meeting to decide names of various stages, en-

ty points," the official added. District Minister of Haveri Shivaram Hebbar has already held two meetings with the members of Kannada Sahitya Parishat and district administration officials regarding the preparations for the Kannada Sahitya Sammelana.

"The hotels in Ranabennur and Hangal are also being reserved for the participants of Sammelana. During the Sammelana, frequent bus services will be provided from the accommodation point to the Sammelana venue," the official said.

A KaSaPa member from Haveri said that if the registrations exceed, the administration will book hotels in Davangere and Hubballi as well. "We have done a survey three months ago looking for accommodation places in Hubballi, Sirsi, Davangere and Ranabennur. At present the administration is looking for create temporary accommodation in hostels and community halls. If the participant numbers are more we will make use of hotels in Davangere too," the member said.

A NWKRTC Bus plying from Gadag to Balaganur toppled as the driver reportedly lost control near Balaganur of Gadag district. A total of 40 passengers were travelling in that bus and 20 passengers got minor injuries. The locals and travellers helped the passengers to get out of the bus. A total of 20 passengers were shifted to GIMS. The incident occurred around 3.45 pm on Sunday.

Some farmers of Hirekoppa said: "We were working in our fields and heard a loud sound. We saw that the bus toppled and fell into the side of a stream that has dried up. Passengers screamed for help. We rushed to the spot and shifted some passengers to GIMS using some vehicles that were passing by. Later, an ambulance arrived and took the remaining passengers to hospital". Gadag Rural police have filed a case.

This park has square swing, circular swing, a four seater see-saw, humpy climber and a saucer with a duck. Villagers are happy as kids will be able to play in a park with modern facilities in their village. Harti is located 13 kilometres from Gadag town.

Harti village's gram panchayat has invested ₹11 lakh on its own to construct this park. The staff saw some children playing in the outskirts of the village and many people expressed concern that there is no park in this village. Then the staff did some research on rural gardens but they found that construction of such a park may cost more than their estimation. Then, the staff checked the most needed equipment for any

park. Senior officials also helped them in getting the funds and the park is ready now. The park will be open for the public from Monday. Children looked joyous and were raring to play in a park in their own village. The staff has decided to get some more equipment in the next phase and make it a standard park sport-

ing all the facilities that parks in cities have.

Villagers said: "We are happy to see a park in our village. We can now take our children there in the evening and they can play with saws, humpy climbers and others. We all thank our gram panchayat staff for implementing the kids' park idea on this Children's Day. Children of Harti village are eagerly waiting for the inauguration."

Six triathletes of Belagavi complete Ironman 70.3 in Goa

AS many as six triathletes from Belagavi including two women successfully completed the gruelling Ironman 70.3 held in Goa on Sunday.

The triathletes of Belagavi comprise - Shanbhag Santosh, Halgekar Indrajeet, Hargude Rohan, Sunthakar Shreya and Shivalkar Mayura (of Venugram Cycling Club, Belagavi) along with Dr Amit Pingat finished the Ironman 70.3 Goa. As many as 1,450 triathletes had participated in the Ironman 70.3 Goa, which was flagged off at the Miramar beach in Panaji on Sunday morning.

The race included a stellar line-up of seasoned and amateur triathletes from India and 33 countries. The 2022 Ironman 70.3 Goa offers qualifying slots for the 2023 Ironman 70.3 World Championship and participants are required to complete a gruelling 1.9 km open sea swim, 90 km cycling and 21 km running.

Shanbhag Santosh clocked a time of 6:22:35, Halgekar Indrajeet - 7:56, Hargude Rohan - 7:55, Sunthakar Shreya - 6:58, Shivalkar Mayura - 7:29 and Dr Amit Pingat - 7:52. Shanbhag had successfully completed

the Ironman UK, Bolton England in July 2022 and the earlier Ironman, Langkawi Malaysia in 2017. He had also participated in the Ironman triathlon event in Goa in 2019 and Ironman Sri Lanka in 2018. Mayura Shivalkar and her son Megh had completed the Ironman Kazakhstan Nur-Sultan Ironman Triathlon. She has also completed the Ironman Colombo in February 2018. Shreya Sunthakar had also successfully completed the Ironman Goa first edition.
