Breaking Pallathuruthy Boat Club's (PBC) long stranglehold, Veeyapuram Chundan (snakeboat) of the Village Boat Club (VBC), Kainakary, rowed to a sensational triumph in the 71st edition of the Nehru Trophy Boat Race (NTBR) on the shimmering waters of Punnamada Lake in Alappuzha, Kerala on Saturday. Veeyapuram surged to victory in a photo finish clocking 4:21.084 and lifted the coveted title in front of thousands of cheering spectators.

One killed, another injured in blast at a house in Kannur

A powerful explosion in a house, where explosives were allegedly being stored for preparing fireworks, in Kannur district of Kerala killed one person and injured another on Saturday. The police identified the deceased as K. Mohammad Asham. The police registered a case against Anoop Malik, Asham's relative, who had taken the house on rent and was a supplier of fireworks. He had been involved in a similar blast at a house at Podikundu in 2016.

M. A. Saleem appointed head of Karnataka police force

Three months after 1993-batch Indian Police Service (IPS) officer M. A. Saleem was made in-charge Director-General and Inspector-General of Police (DG&IGP), the Karnataka government on Saturday formalised his appointment and made him the full-time Head of Police Force. However, the order issued by Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms on Saturday appointing Dr. Saleem does not mention a two-year tenure.

Telangana Assembly to take up Bill on 42% BC quota today

Former BRS govt. reduced reservation for Backward Classes in local body polls from 34% to 23% to overcome the ceiling set by Supreme Court; Minister says all parties have backed the new Bill

he Telangana government will introduce a new Bill in the Assembly on Sunday to provide 42% reservation for Backward Classes (BCs) in local body elections, replacing the Ordinance on the Panchayat Raj Amendment Act, breaking the 50% upper ceiling on total reservation.

The decision was taken at the Cabinet meeting on Saturday. The proposed legislation will replace the Telangana Panchayat Raj Act, 2018, brought during the previous Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) government's tenure under K. Chandrashekar Rao, which


led to the reduction of quota for BCs from 34% to 23% to overcome the 50% upper ceiling of the Supreme Court.

Backward Classes Wel-Minister Ponnam Prabhakar told reporters after the Cabinet meeting that the new Bill would be introduced in the Assembly as all the parties are in agreement on enhancement of the reservation.

Mr. Prabhakar said the Panchayat Raj Act, 2018 was the biggest hurdle as it capped the total reservation for the SCs, STs and BCs in local bodies at 50%.

The government had issued an Ordinance to amend the 2018 Act, and the Bill replaces the Ordinance. The Ordinance issued last month is pending with the President. The Cabinet decided to grant reservation to the SCs and the STs as per the 2001 census in the local bodies, he said. The government will justify the enhancement citing the Socio, Economic, Educational, Employment, Political and Caste Survey, which places the BC population in Telangana at 56%

The amendment under consideration seeks to authorise the Chief Wildlife Warden "to permit any person, by following certain procedures, to kill, tranquillise or capture a

wild animal if it attacks someone and causes serious injury or if such an animal is found in a public place," Mr. Rajeeve said.

Mr. Rajeeve was addressing a conference organised by the Kerala State Legal Services Authority and the National Legal Ser-Authority vices Saturday.

The decision to propose an amendment to a Central law is based on the legal advice that the State government is competent to propose such an amendment, Mr. Rajeeve said.

the government proposes to introduce the Bill, which is awaiting Cabinet nod, in the upcoming session of the State Assembly. Since the amendment concerns a Central law, the Bill, once passed by the Assembly, would also require the assent of the President, he

He told *The Hindu* that

Article 254(2) of the Constitution allows a State legislature to pass a law on a subject on the Concurrent List.

"In the context of human-wildlife conflict, the State has struggled for years under the limitations of the Central law," Mr. Rajeeve said, observing that human-wildlife conflict has reached a critical stage in Kerala, posing a serious threat to human welfare. Observing that margi-

nalised sections were the most affected due to this conflict, Mr. Rajeeve also drew attention to the resolution passed by the State Assembly in February 2024 urging the Centre to amend the Wildlife Protection Act for mitigating human-wildlife conflicts.
